She is an elected member of the Affinity Credit Union District Council, University of Saskatchewan Senate, and serves as a nationally elected director for the Canadian Institute of Planners.

In 2013, Kelley and her team received the Premier’s Award for Excellence in the Public Service for work to expand services for individuals living with intellectual disabilities. Since this time, she has been honoured with the Canadian Institute of Planners President’s Award for distinguished contribution to planning, the Saskatchewan Professional Planning Institute Fraser-Gatrell Memorial Award, and the Business and Professional Women Athena Award from professional excellence, community service and actively supporting women in their achievement of excellence.

Most importantly, Kelley is a proud Leadership Saskatoon Alumna who sincerely believes her learnings from the program were instrumental in setting her leadership path. Kelley enjoys volunteering her time as a mentor to emerging professionals.
